### Student Expectation Quick Guide

#### Dress Code

- No student shall be permitted to wear any clothing, head coverings, or jewelry that contains pictures and/or writing referring or making inferences to alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, sexual references, profanity, promotion of gambling, illegal drugs, racism and/or gangs. Clothing items that cause intimidation or disrupt the learning of others are prohibited.
- Coats and hoods should be removed when entering the building.
- The principal or teacher may restrict the wearing of hats when it interferes with the instruction and behavior of the students. If hats are allowed, ears must be showing and hats are worn forward facing.
- No exposed stomach, chest, back, buttocks, or undergarments.
- Elementary School - Backpacks are not allowed to be carried during the school day except for students going to or from physical education.

***\*\*Students who violate the rules, shall be asked to change or be provided appropriate clothing to wear for the day. Continued violation of the district's dress code may result in disciplinary action.***

#### Food/Drink

- Food must be eaten in the designated areas. No food should be consumed in classrooms unless approved by appropriate staff.
- High sugar drinks, soda, or carbonated beverages are not allowed during the school day unless approved by appropriate staff.
- If there is a question of water bottle content, bottles will be confiscated and checked.

#### Hallway Use

- Academic time is important. Students should report to class on time and ready to learn.
- No more than one student can be dismissed from a class at a time.
- Teacher approval to leave the classroom is required.
- Any student in the halls during class time is required to have a hall pass from their classroom teacher.

#### Cell Phone Use

- High School students: Cell phones or other personal electronic devices are not to be used in the classrooms unless authorized by the classroom teacher for academic purposes.
- Elementary and Middle School students are not allowed to use personal electronic devices (cell phones, ipods, Apple watches, etc.) at any time or any place throughout the school day. Devices are to be placed in the office or put away and powered off during the instructional day.
- Students needing to contact their parents during the school day must report to the office to call.

***\*\*If personal electronic devices are used, seen, or misused during the school day, they will be confiscated and brought to the office.***

#### Chromebook Use

- School Chromebooks are to be used appropriately in the classroom. They will be confiscated if students abuse the chromebook and/or use it inappropriately. Parents will be charged for any preventable damage to a Chromebook.
- Middle School and Elementary School students are not allowed to take the chromebooks out of school without the permission of their teacher or principal. If chromebooks are allowed home, it is for educational purposes and very limited.
- School chromebook use is always monitored by staff.

#### Public Display of Affection

- Hand holding is allowed, but no other physical displays of affection are allowed.
